

Fabric Furniture Care & Maintenance

Extend the life of your new furniture by following these simple maintenance tips:

Regular cleaning

- Vacuum frequently to prevent soiling. Use a soft bristle brush attachment, be sure no rotary motion is applied.
- Blot spills rather than rubbing when cleaning.
- Cleaning protocol varies depending on the makeup of your fabric. Your cleaning code is highlighted below as specified by your manufacturer. Pretest the method first on a small unseen area.

Norwalk Furniture Cleaning Codes:

W: Spot clean this fabric with the foam only of a water-based cleaning agent to remove over-all soil.	S: cleaning should be performed by a professional furniture cleaning service, using a solvent-based cleaning agent.
S-W: Spot clean this fabric with the foam only of a water-based cleaning agent or with a pure solvent in a well-ventilated room.	D: Cleaning should be performed by a professional furniture cleaning service, using a solvent based cleaning agent. Do not use any tumble method cleaning service as this may damage the fabric. Never remove cushion covers for dry cleaning, even though they have zippers.
W-S: Clean water type stains with water-based cleaning agents and for oil type stains, use solvent-based cleaning agents, both designed for upholstery. Do not saturate.	

Comfort Design Cleaning Codes:

S: Spot clean using a mild water-free solvent or dry cleaning product. Clean only in a well-ventilated room and avoid any product containing carbon tetrachloride which is highly toxic.	W: Use a water-based upholstery cleaner only.
WS: Spot clean with a mild solvent, an upholstery shampoo or the foam from a mild detergent. When using a solvent or dry cleaning product, follow instructions carefully and clean only in a well-ventilated room. Use a professional when an overall soiled condition has been reached.	SW: Spot clean with upholstery shampoo, foam from a mild detergent or mild dry cleaning solvent. Do not saturate. Pile fabrics may require brushing with a non-metallic, stiff bristle brush to restore appearance. Hot water extraction or steam cleaning NOT recommended. Use a professional when overall soiled condition has been reached.
